

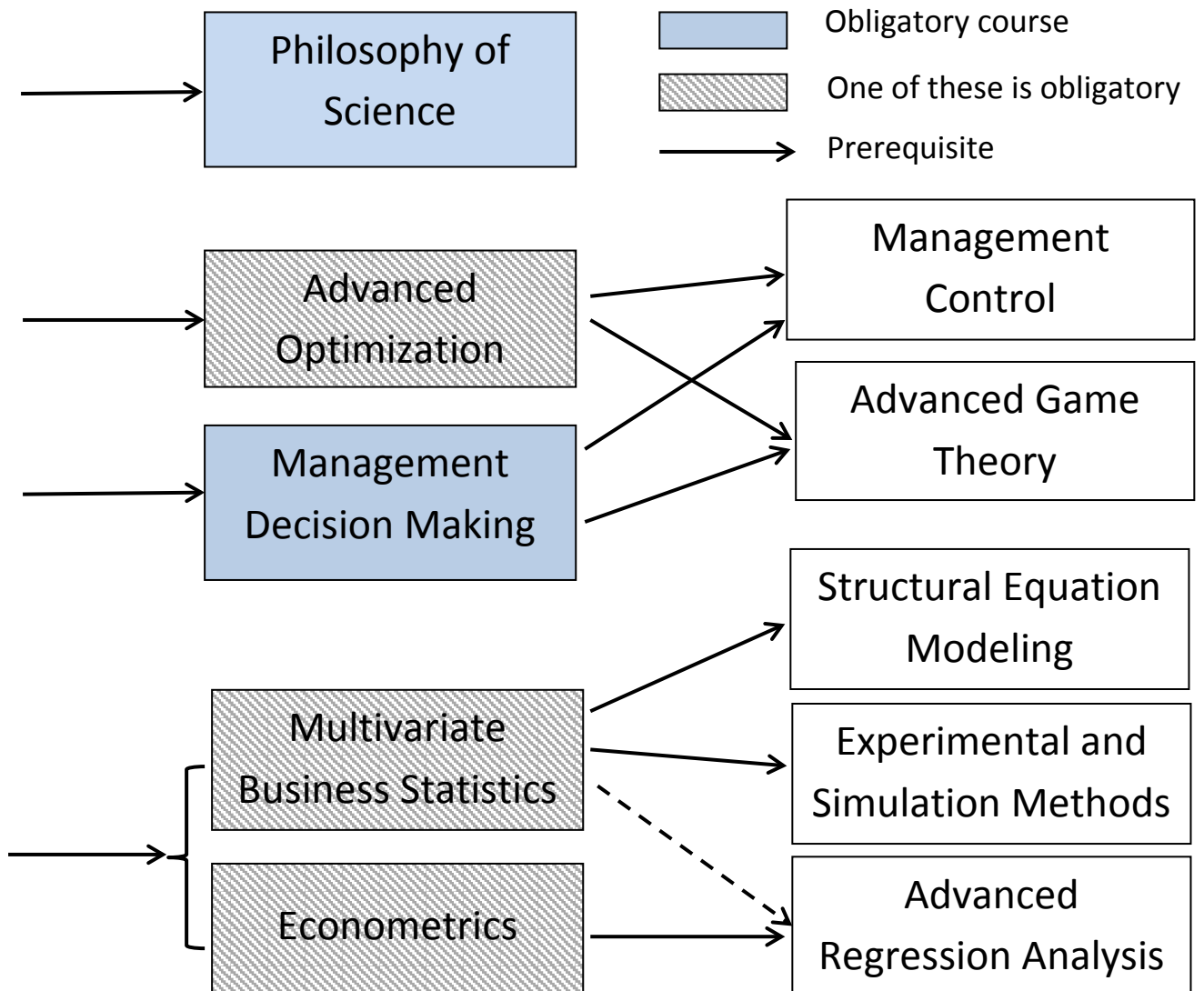
Structure of the PhD-Management Program

Preamble

Pursuant to Statute § 16 of the University of Vienna, a dissertation contract must be concluded between the student and supervisor with the approval of the doctoral program committee. Among other things this regulates in detail which courses have to be attended, having regard to the structured program.

1) Core-Program (5 courses)

- Philosophy of Science (PoS)
- Advanced Optimization (AO)
- Management Decision Making (MDM)
- Either Multivariate Business Statistics (MBS) or Econometrics (EM): appropriate course of the Department of Statistics depending on the courses offered (Ökonometrie, Introductory econometrics, Microeconometrics, Mikroökonomie)
- Management Control (MC): prerequisite MDM and AO
- Advanced Game Theory (AGT): prerequisite MDM and AO
- Structural Equation Modeling (SEM): prerequisite MBS
- Experimental and Simulation Methods (EMS): prerequisite MBS
- Advanced Regression Analysis (ARA): prerequisite EM (MBS in exceptional cases)



2) Elective Program (2 courses)

Prerequisite: MDM, MBS/AO/EM

- Courses from the Elective Program Management (Qualitative Research Methods, Marketing Models, etc.)
- Courses from other doctorate programs (Finance, Economics)

Courses shall be selected according to the dissertation contract.

3) Research seminars (5 seminars)

- 3 doctorate seminars
- Obligatory: 1 presentation of research question, methodology and structure of the dissertation project in a faculty-wide research seminar
- Obligatory: 1 presentation of the results of the dissertation in a faculty-wide research seminar

4) Defensio of the dissertation
