4. Organizational Issues for Students of both Curricula

Students are required to register for the seminar via [U:SPACE](#).

The presentation should contain a maximum of 40 slides and the slides are to be sent to opim.bwl@univie.ac.at 10 days before the presentation.

If a student registers for a presentation but cancels this appointed date later, any registration for a presentation in the next semester will be dealt with minor priority; i.e., another date for presentation will be assigned only if there is capacity available which has not been claimed by other doctoral students (usually 12 options are offered per semester: four dates with three presentation spots each).
