Think Business Berlin-Vienna-Zurich

About the programme

"Think Business, Go International! Berlin-Vienna-Zurich" is a structured Master mobility exchange programme of three top universities in Germany, Austria, and Switzerland. The programme provides rigorous quantitative training for master students in business administration or management & economics. The programme prepares students to be future business leaders and academics.

Structure

- (1) Spend an exchange semester at one of the partner institutions (with a whitelist of courses offered at the two guest institutions that are guaranteed to be recognized for the master in business administration or management & economics at the home institution)
- (2) Participate in one mandatory and one voluntary one-week summer school in either Berlin, Vienna, or Zurich. The summer school includes networking events with faculty members and business leaders. Students completing the programme earn a diploma signed by the partner institutions, supplementing the master degree of their home university.

Who can apply?

Excellent Master students of the business programmes at Humboldt University (including the Master of Economics and Management Science), the University of Vienna and the Management & Economics Program at University of Zurich can apply. Applicants are expected to have solid training in quantitative business research and microeconomics and to work hard to get the most of the programme in a short period. The programme provides ample opportunities for team building and networking. Students get access to a close-knit cohort of future leaders in business or academia. For applicants from the University of

Vienna, priority is given to students in the first semester of the Master in Busines Administration at the Faculty of Business, Economics and Statistics with excellent grades in "Empirical Methods" and "Microeconomic Foundations".

Please include in your application:

- (1) a CV;
- (2) a short statement of purpose;
- (3) first semester master transcripts (or print-out if not issued yet);
- (4) bachelor transcripts;
- (5) the preferred location for the exchange semester (Berlin, Vienna or Zurich),

Application deadline for Vienna students is March 9, 2017 Candidates will be notified by March 20, 2017

Fees & Finance

No fees are charged, neither for studying in the Structured Mobility Programme as such, nor for participating in the summer school. However, participants have to cover their own travel costs and living expenses during all parts of the programme, including the summer school. Depending on external financial support, a small number of modest stipends might be available, but cannot be guaranteed. Students from Vienna and Berlin have the option to apply for an Erasmus grant.
